c. Registration Updates

i. Organizational discussion/follow up regarding out of district registrants

Coach Dave doesn't want any non-NL kids in the midget program. He is talking to others in the district about it. Feels it is the NL HS JV program. Thinks they shouldn't have to pay. However, need to maintain equipment, etc. Dave is in favor of bringing back a Junior High program for 7-8-9. We would then be competing between Jr high program and Midget. Neither team would win.

Ron and Phil are in communication with Rice. He suspended the Jr High program because he liked what the NLMFA was doing. Adam talked with Coach Rice after the last meeting. Doesn't want to kick the kids out. Anyone currently playing is grandfathered in and will eventually filter out. Adam likes the relationship between the 2 organizations and doesn't want to kick anyone out. Smurf to Pony would stay the same. Make midgets NL only. Or find another league with Jr High that wouldn't compete with us and we'd do up to Pony. This wasn't mentioned to the board previously. Has come up after recent changes to the board. Josh Thompson came in to help with the midgets when we had super low numbers. Several 9th graders have already said they weren't going to play this year and would come out later on. Other leagues have different age ranges, so we'd have to change ours to match. Basketball is making changes like this, but they are travel teams, not rec teams like our football team is.

Start doing research NOW on other leagues to see what is available. Keep an open agenda item to discuss until we get a resolution.

Adam and Susan are going to have a discussion with Dave about this issue. Dru volunteered to mediate the meeting with Dave.

Also going to have a discussion with Coach Rice and Dr. Kyper about if there is a possibility for a Jr High team at all. That will help drive our decision making and research.

Coach Adam wants to close the peewee and midgets to NEW non-NL kids. Returning players are still good. Won't have enough for JV, so we want to make sure we get kids playing time. Leave Pony and Smurf's open.

Smurf - Midget need to have the CFA physical form. Encourage to email or bring to camp, not collected by coaches. Millers and Benethems will still sign up.

Could use more cheerleaders at the midget and Smurf level! Encourage the Itty Bitty players and cheerleaders to sign up!
